- 2) Roll Call (18:07) Present: Frank Grimsley, Tara Shaia, Maureen Brennan, Elizabeth Genai Absent: Angie Noble
- 3) Pledge of Allegiance (18:08)
- 4) Approve previous minutes: 4 yes, 1 absent (18:09)
- 5) Public Comment: (18:11) No public comment
- 6) Agenda items: (18:12) Preliminary budget, approved by Board, and starts July 1 2024. September board meeting is a finalized budget.
- 7.) Chief Ramirez presented preliminary budget for Measure O. See attachment. \$904,000. = "beginning fund balance." Total revenue=\$2.6 million. Per Member Shaia, \$904,000 is missing from Total Balance. Large sum! Chief will review and revise as needed.
- 8.) Member Shaia asked if CERT training is included in new Measure O budget, as previously requested. The Chief mentioned several reasons why it's not possible at this time. Oversight, personnel time, training volunteers, etc.
- 9.) Chair Brennan asked if Station 74 in Pinole is open. Chief says yes. Not apparent as Station appears closed.
- 10.) (24:05) Measure O report dropped from Board agenda. It was pointed out that these mistakes are ongoing. Members complained of "stonewalling" and unanswered questions at the ConFire/Broussard presentation. What service will we get for our Measure O money, should annexation occur? There occurred a continued discussion of benefits to the community vs. the best interest of the firefighters.
- 11.) Measure O makes for an "uneven" playing field. A recommendation was made to make a request of the Board, that, should annexation occur, the Measure O tax should be dissolved/ terminated. Also suggested is to havbe a public vote for Measure O to be terminated. This is actually part of the Ordinance, that a public vote is required to terminate

Measure O. Elizabeth Genai, made motion to ask Board for an advisory statement to terminate Measure O upon annexation, second by Frank Grimsley. After further discussion, vote was deferred to a later date.
