A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RODEO HERCULES FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ADOPTING A PRELIMINARY BUDGET FOR THE 2024-25 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the CA H&S § 13895 requires that on or before June 30th of each year, a district board shall adopt a preliminary budget which shall conform to the accounting and budgeting procedures for special districts contained in Subchapter 3 (commencing with Section 1031.1) of, and Article 1 (commencing with Section 1121) of Subchapter 4 of, Chapter 2 of Division 2 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations. If the Board is unable to adopt a budget before the deadline, the previous fiscal year budget will remain in place until a preliminary budget is adopted.

WHEREAS, the preliminary budget for the 2024-25 fiscal year has been prepared in compliance with the Health and Safety Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, a final budget will be brought to the Board in September 2024; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS: The Preliminary Budget for the Rodeo Hercules Fire Protection District for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025, is hereby adopted by the Board of Directors of the Rodeo Hercules Fire Protection District as set forth and shall serve as the Preliminary Budget.

IF ANY PART OF THE RESOLUTION OR ANY ATTACHMENTS TO IT are for any reason determined to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution or it attachments, and the Board hereby declares that it would have adopted this Resolution, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, and phrase hereof, irrespective of any one or more sections, subsection, sentences, clauses or phrases being declared invalid or unconstitutional.
